

# Residential Participant Protocols

## City Center Health and Safety

### Fall Practice Period 2022

#### COVID-19 Safety Requirements:

- Participants are required to be vaccinated and have at least one booster shot (if eligible).
- As part of the registration process, participants are required to fill out this [COVID-19 Safety Questionnaire](#).
- Participants are required to review section 1 and section 2 of the [City Center Health and Safety Protocols](#) sheet (see section titles “Outside the Temple” and “Inside the Temple”).
- *Testing:* PCR testing is required before arrival, within 72 hours of coming to City Center. This is followed by three rapid antigen tests– one on arrival day, one on day 3 and one on day 5.
- *Masking:* Participants are required to wear masks full-time for their first 3 days in residence and can unmask in the temple after that point, pending negative rapid test results. Participants are then allowed to remain unmasked for the remainder of their stay, should they only engage in low-risk activities. Participants who wish to engage in higher risk activities outside the temple (e.g., eating inside a restaurant) are required to mask in the temple for 5 days following the high risk activity. Please see the [City Center Health and Safety Protocols](#) sheet for a more complete explanation of high and low risk activities. There is one temple activity that always requires masking (regardless of engagement in high or low risk activities): residents must always wear a mask while chanting.
